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## ***Highlights of 2012-13 – Bethany’s 108<sup>th</sup> year***

- ◆ Eleven MDiv degrees, one MA, and a Certificate of Achievement in Theological Studies were granted in May.
- ◆ A capacity crowd attended Bethany’s fifth Presidential Forum, “The Bible in Our Bones: Telling and Living the Stories of Our Faith.”
- ◆ Ruthann Johansen’s tenure as president was recognized with a community celebration, during which the new fully funded Ruthann Knechel Johansen Endowment for Theology in Literature was announced.
- ◆ Russell Haitch was promoted to professor of Christian education. He also serves as director of the Institute for Ministry with Youth and Young Adults.
- ◆ Malinda Berry, instructor of theological studies, received her doctorate from Union Theological Seminary. In addition, she was promoted to assistant professor of theological studies.
- ◆ Faculty and staff were present denominationally and professionally through numerous sermons, workshops, lectures, district conferences and insight sessions, professional event leadership, international presentations, and published works.
- ◆ As of April 30, 2013, 80 percent of the \$5.9 million goal had been raised in gifts and pledges through the ongoing Reimagining Ministries campaign.
