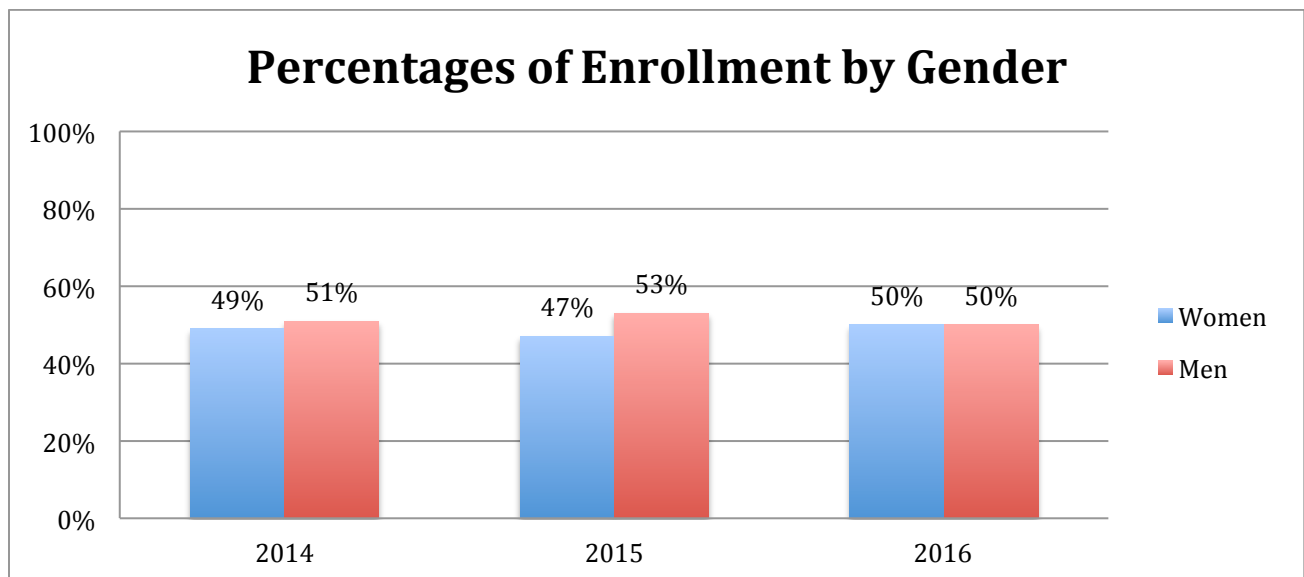
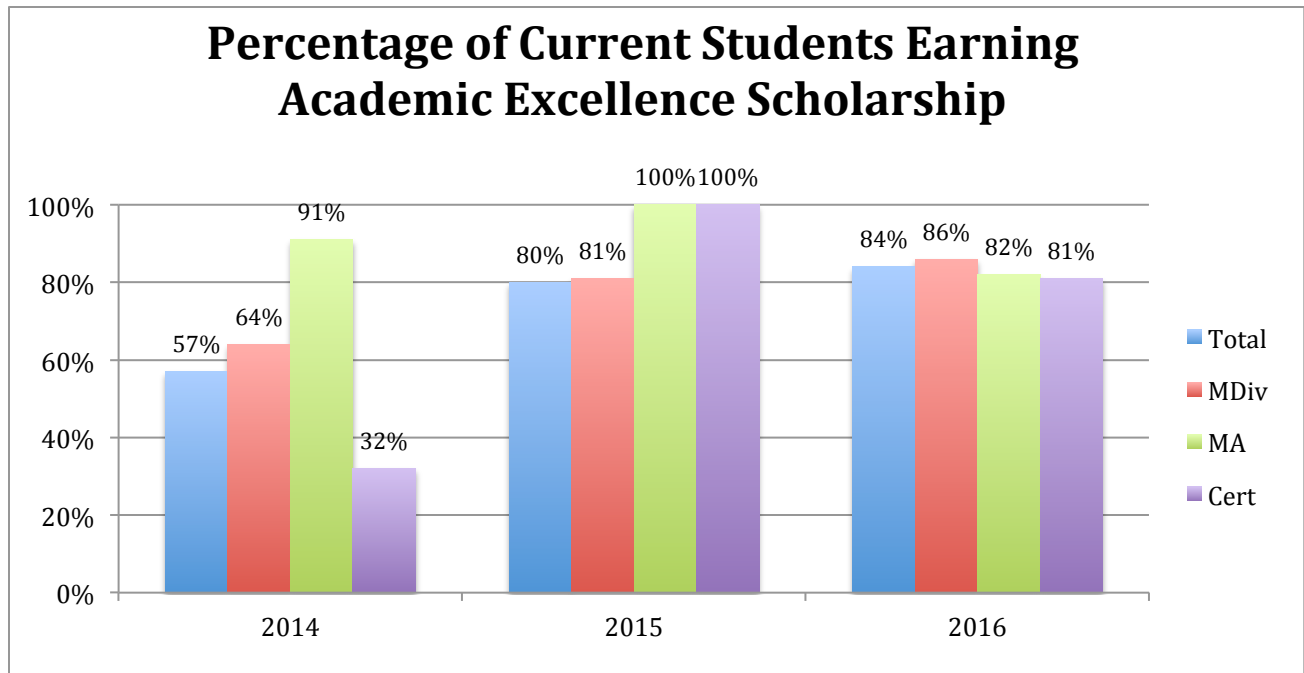
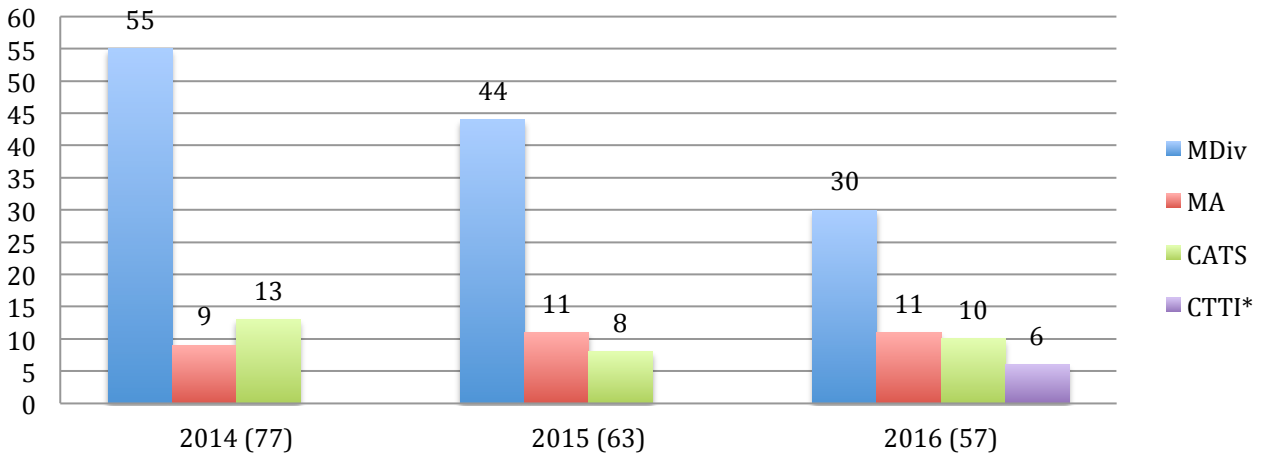


Educational Effectiveness at Bethany Theological Seminary

Student Enrollment Numbers by Program

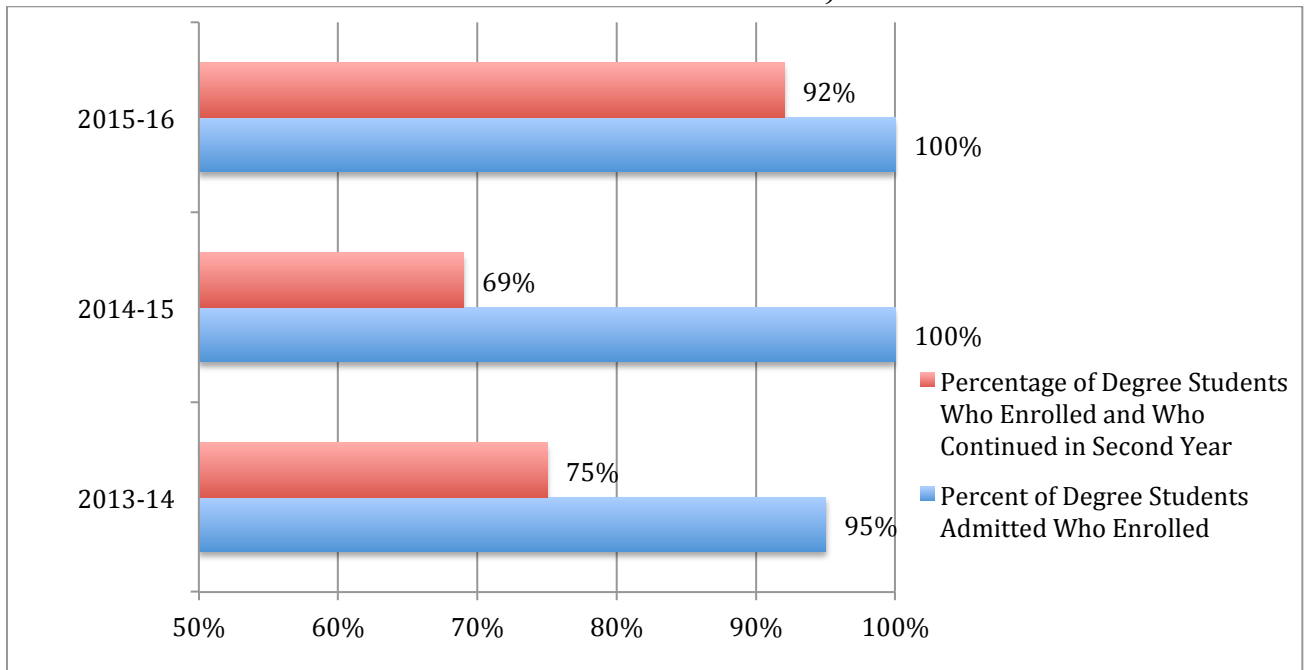

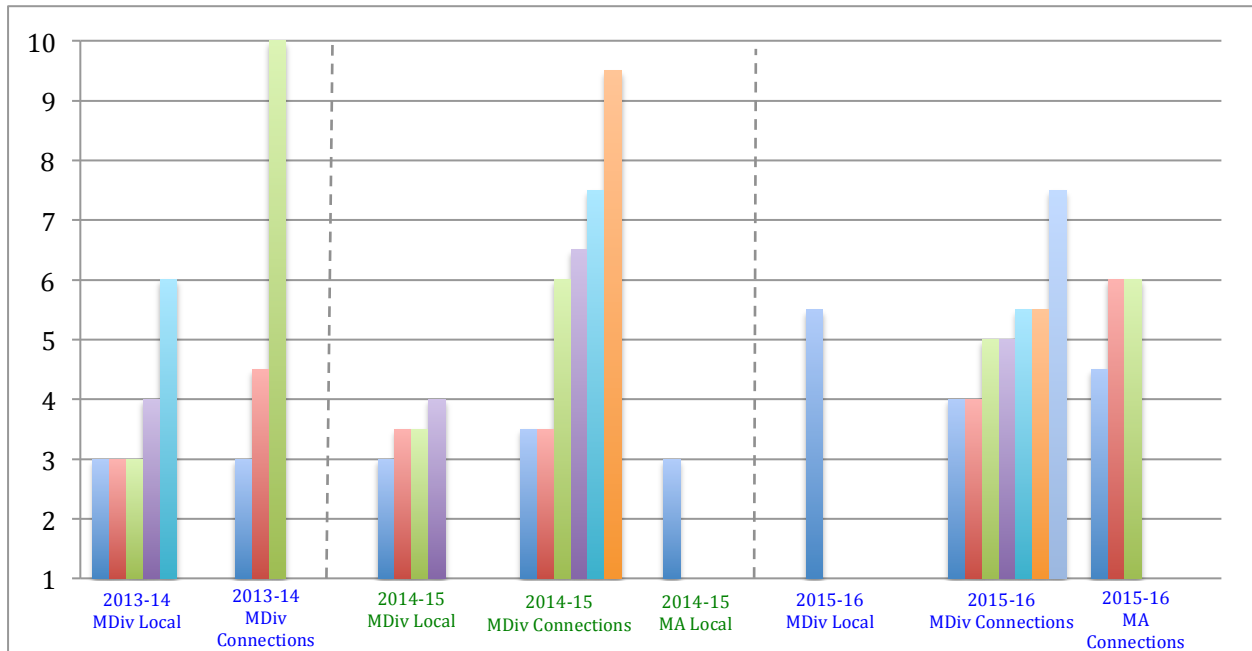

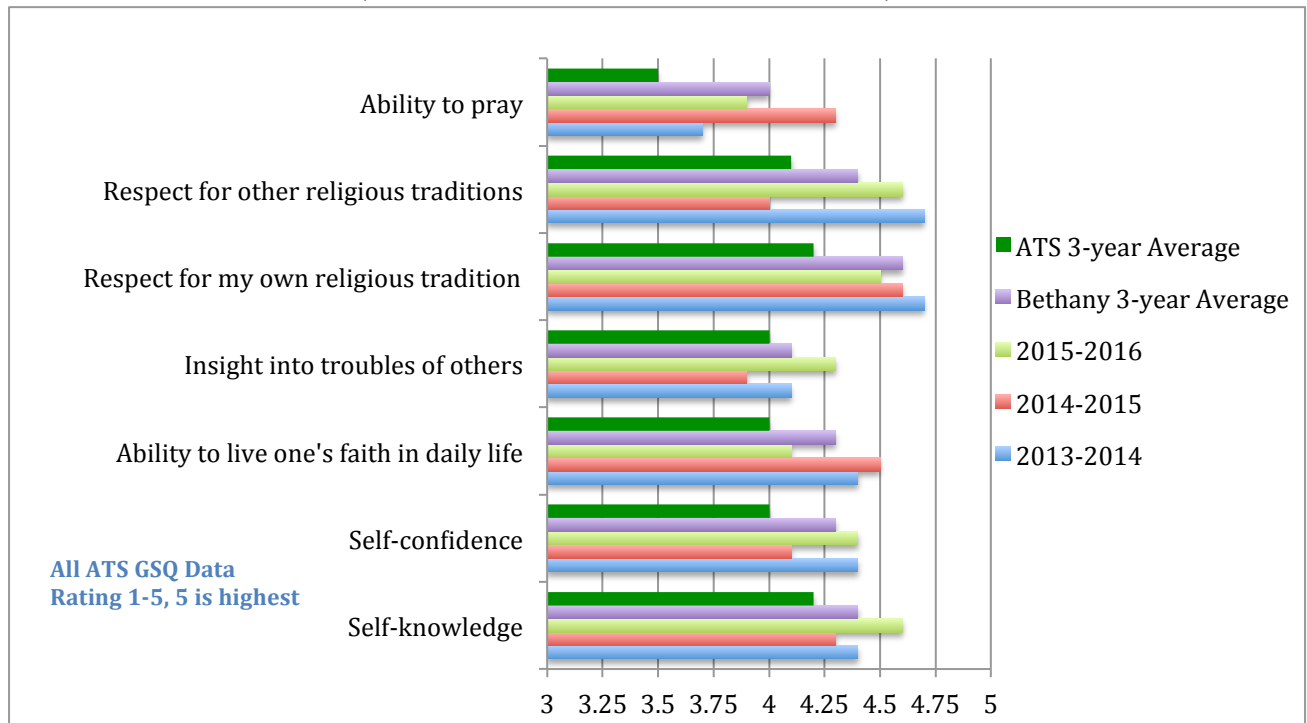
Student Retention into Second Year, Fall Enrollment



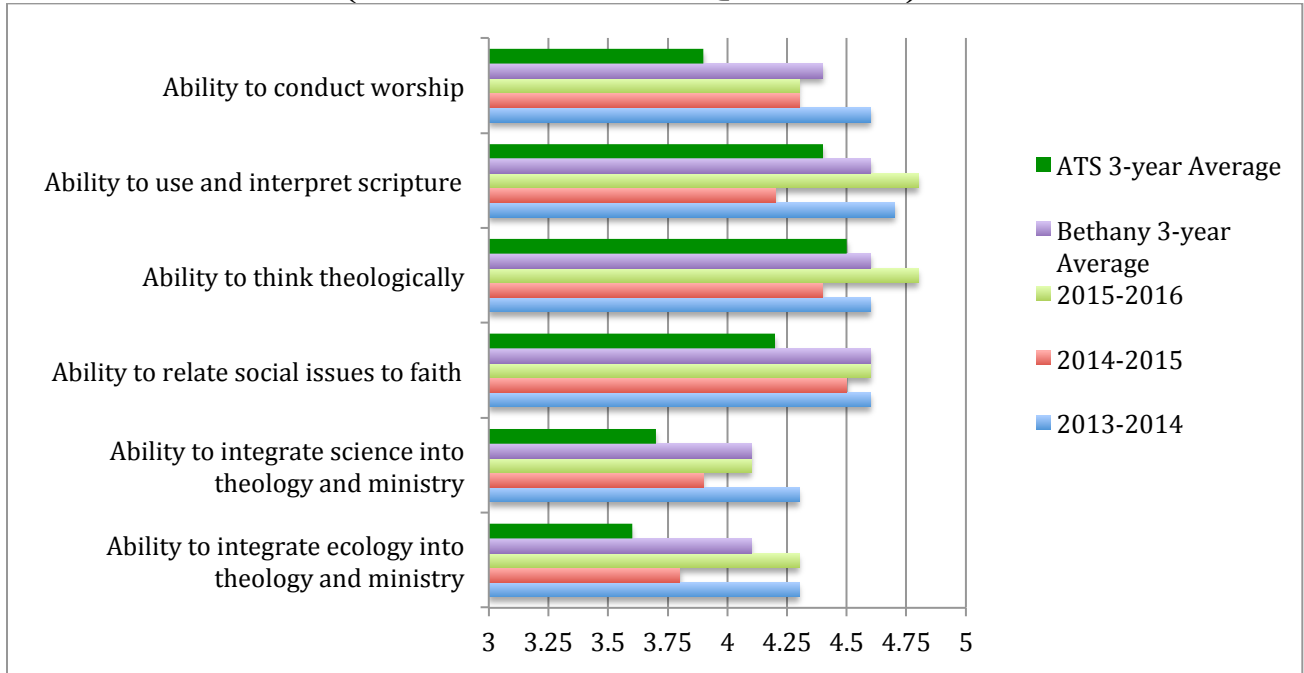
Degree Program Completion (in Years) for Each Graduate



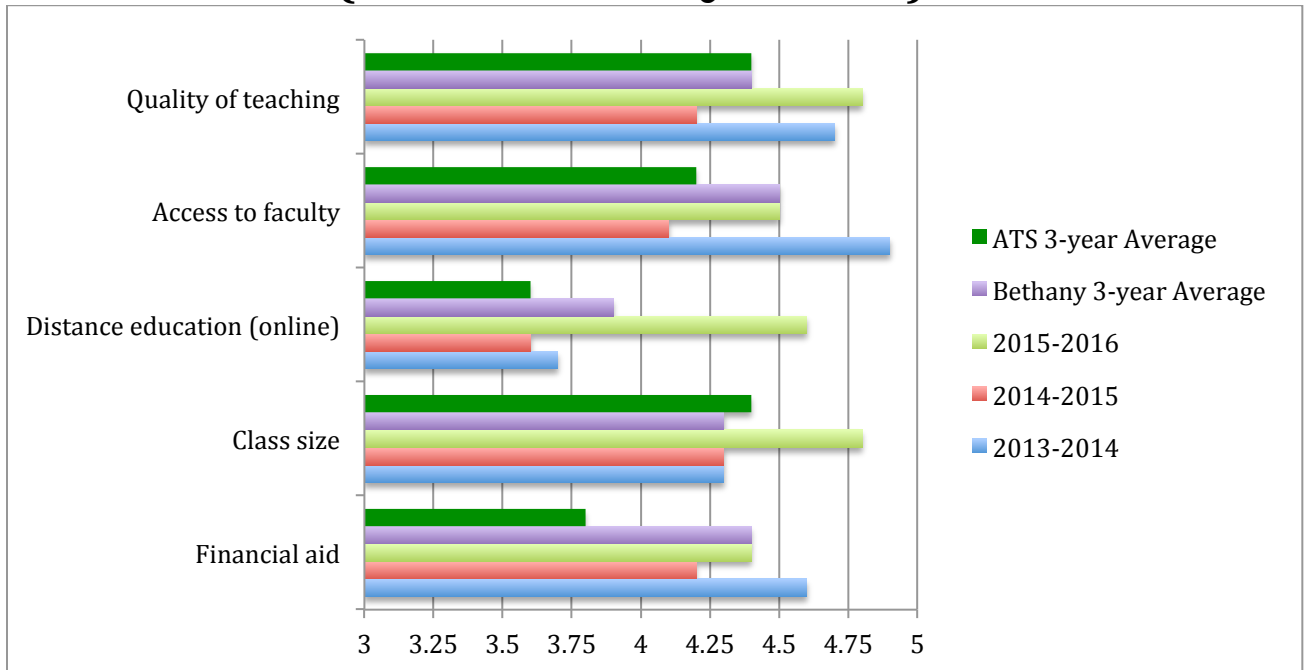
Measure of Personal Growth after Theological Program (Source: ATS GSQ table 14)



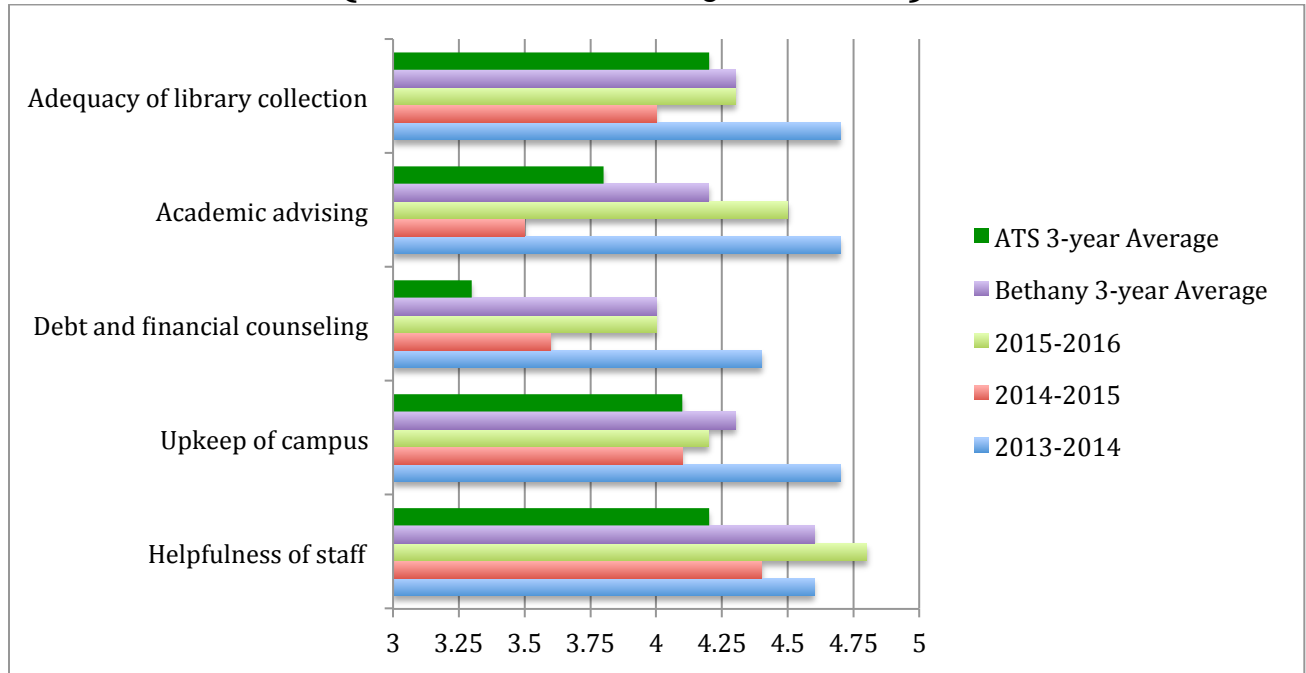
Satisfaction with Skills Related to Future Work (Source: ATS GSQ table 15)
