



Job Posting Faculty Position in Ministry Formation

Bethany Theological Seminary invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track faculty position in Ministry Formation, beginning fall 2019. Rank: open. DMin or PhD preferred; ABD considered. Previous or current ministry experience and ordination are preferred.

The appointee will be expected to teach an average of five graduate courses per year, including at least one online course per year, and to offer one nongraduate course for the Brethren Academy biennially. These courses include the introductory MDiv course and oversight of required MDiv student placements in ministry settings. They contain a significant emphasis on personal, spiritual, and vocational formation and are central to Bethany's MDiv program. While directing field education comprises part of this position, Bethany values the teaching by this member of the faculty as an integral aspect of the curriculum and a key element in the holistic formation of MDiv students. A secondary field of study consistent with faculty expertise and Bethany's curricular goals will be part of the course load.

Other duties will include: student advising, serving on at least one major institutional committee annually, participating in the recruitment of new students through interviews and informal contacts, regular participation in faculty meetings and other campus events, and opportunities for speaking engagements within the Church of the Brethren and other settings. Commitment to the values and theological emphases of the Church of the Brethren is essential.

We specifically encourage applications from women, Latinos/Latinas, African-Americans, and other ethnic minorities. The appointment will begin on July 1, 2019.
