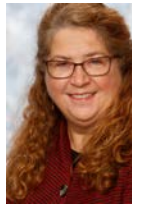

This course will be led by Janet Ober Lambert, Director of the Brethren Academy for Ministerial Leadership (BAML), with technical support from Fran Massie, BAML's Administrative Assistant, and Bethany Seminary's Director of Educational Technology, Dan Poole.

Ethics for the Set-Apart Ministry: Basic Course will take place via webcast on Saturday, June 1, 2019 from 10:00 am – 4:00 pm eastern time with a break for lunch. A website link will be emailed to all participants a few days prior to the webcast. This link will connect you to the webcast room. Course workbooks will be mailed to participants via USPS.

The curriculum for this training has been newly created for the Church of the Brethren by James Benedict, a Church of the Brethren pastor and medical ethicist. James has created this course at both the Basic (introductory) level and the Advanced level. The Basic Course offers an introduction to the discipline and application of ethics through scripture and case studies. The Advanced Course calls on the experience of fully credentialed clergy to dig more deeply into the scriptures and explore more complex case studies. The Basic Course is offered several times a year by the Brethren Academy on behalf of the Office of Ministry. The Advanced Course is reviewed every 5 years for ministers wishing to maintain their credentials in the Church of the Brethren.
