## FORMAL COMPLAINT

If this is an emergency, call 911.

Title IX is a federal law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in education programs or activities receiving federal financial assistance. Sexual harassment is a form of sex discrimination, and Title IX defines sexual harassment as conduct on the basis of sex that constitutes one or more of the following three types of behavior:

- 1. Quid Pro Quo harassment
- 2. Severe, Pervasive, and Objectively Offensive Conduct that Denies a Party Equal Educational Access
- 3. Sexual Assault, Dating Violence, Domestic Violence, and Stalking

Under Title IX, Bethany Theological Seminary is obligated to investigate formal complaints of sexual harassment and will treat parties equally and equitably throughout the grievance process. In accordance with the Bethany Theological Seminary Sexual Misconduct & Sexual Harassment Policy, formal complaints of incidents of **sexual harassment** as defined under Title IX involving Bethany students or employees will be addressed using **Process A: Title IX Formal Complaint & Grievance Process**, found in Section VI. of the policy.

For more information about the definitions of sexual harassment, filing a formal complaint, and the Title IX investigation and grievance process, refer to the <u>Bethany Theological Seminary Policy</u> on Sexual Misconduct & Sexual Harassment.

IMPORTANT: ONLY THE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS THE ALLEGED VICTIM OF CONDUCT THAT COULD CONSTITUTE SEXUAL HARASSMENT ("COMPLAINANT") MAY FILE A FORMAL COMPLAINT.

Filing a formal complaint will initiate **Process A: Title IX Formal Complaint & Grievance Process,** which requires notifying the respondent of the allegations and grievance process.

If at any time during the course of the investigation and grievance process in **Process A: Title IX Formal Complaint & Grievance Process,** the Title IX Coordinator determines that the alleged sexual harassment no longer falls within the jurisdictional criteria of Title IX, the allegation may be addressed under **Process B: Sexual Misconduct Complaint Resolution Process.** 

The Title IX Coordinator will provide the parties with written notice simultaneously in the event that the grievance process used to handle the complaint of sexual misconduct must be changed.

If you are a Complainant and would like to discuss Bethany's policies and grievance procedures before filing a formal complaint, please complete the Incident Report rather than this form.

If you are a third-party reporter or wish to report anonymously, you may report the incident using the Incident Report rather than this form.

If the Title IX Coordinator receives a formal complaint which does not meet the Title IX definition of sexual harassment, they will contact the complainant to discuss available options.

In this document, you will see various terms. The definitions of these terms are below:

Complainant: An individual who is alleged to be the victim of conduct that could constitute sexual harassment

Respondent: An individual who has been reported to be the perpetrator of conduct that could constitute sexual harassment

Witness: An individual with first-hand knowledge of the alleged incident. This may include someone you told about the alleged incident after it occurred.
