Course Description and Objectives

Multivocational ministry is a reality in many denominations. It is not only a calling, but a necessity; part-time ministry placements often outnumber full-time placements. Stephen Norcross writes "A part-time arrangement between pastor and congregation does not mean that the person is a part-time pastor, nor that the congregation is a part-time church." This class will explore the set-apart ministry within the multivocational context, including the rewards and challenges for both pastor and congregation. Topics include the multivocational ministry of the Apostle Paul and an investigation of 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, and Titus.

Students will:

- Define the set-apart ministry within the multivocational context.
- Interpret the scriptural foundation for multivocational ministry and church organization through Pauline writings.
- Explore ways to incorporate time management skills needed for multivocational ministry.
- Describe ways to motivate leadership within your congregation.
- Recognize your ministry calling and your secular occupation as one mission instead of viewing them as two competing sides vying for your time.
