New Course Spotlight

Cultivating an Everyday Faith



The Brethren Academy for Ministerial Leadership is proud to offer a newly developed course entitled "Cultivating an Everyday Faith," taught by Joan Daggett.

Post-pandemic research shows that churches continue to struggle to engage children and families in the life of the congregation. In this course, students will explore ways to nurture an everyday faith in church, home, and community. We will look deeper into the needs of today's children and families, explore the pivotal role that families have in the faith formation of their children, and discuss how churches can support families in that role. Along the way, students will craft a working plan to support and empower families to cultivate a way of life, help them link stories from the Bible to everyday living, and encourage them to live out Jesus' teachings in

their neighborhoods and communities.

This timely course will be offered online, April 17-June 11, 2024. This course fulfills the teaching and learning in the church requirement.

Travel Grants Available for "Polarization as an Opportunity for Ministry"

As part of Bethany Theological Seminary's initiative to "Build Bridges Across Ideological Divides", the Brethren Academy for Ministerial Leadership is offering a series of TRIM-level courses to help clergy recognize and meaningfully address division in their congregations and communities. First up is "Polarization as an Opportunity for Ministry", a course with Russell Haitch, Professor of Theology and Human Science at Bethany Theological Seminary.

This course will look at both problems and solutions. It will examine politics, evolving media, AI, and other forces driving divisions. At the same time, participants will explore how leaders can help people find common ground—and higher ground—in situations of strife. Participants will address both the theological content and pastoral skills that leaders need in order to be agents of reconciliation and Christ-centered unity in an era of polarization.

This course is being offered as an onsite intensive at Bethany Theological Seminary in Richmond, Indiana. Course dates are April 11-13, 2024, with two additional Zoom sessions to be scheduled, one before and one after the time at Bethany.

The Brethren Academy will provide a travel stipend of up to \$300 for 8 pastors or church leaders who register for this course. The stipend is to offset travel costs, reimbursement upon submission of travel receipts. To qualify for a travel grant, individuals must be currently and actively serving a congregation. Those who wish to apply for a travel grant may email the Brethren Academy at academy@bethanyseminary.edu for an application.


