Directed Independent Study Unit (DISU) Description and Objectives

In his book, *The Like to Never Quit Praisin' God: The Role of Celebration in Preaching*, Frank A Thomas reflects on the power of a sermon that "facilitates the experience of the assurance of grace." When the hearers of such a sermon truly experience the good news of the Gospel, genuine praise follows. After extensive research into the power and genius of African American preaching, Thomas identifies several key components of preaching that can inspire such genuine praise. This course is a companion to the Brethren Ministers' Association continuing education event on "Listening for the Sound of the Genuine" on July 2-3, 2024. The event will be led by Frank A. Thomas, who has studied and written about the role of the preacher in communicating genuine faith and celebratory praise.

Students who participate in this DISU will examine their own preaching, specifically what is said and how it is said. After completing this course, students will be able to:

- evaluate sermons for what is communicated through the words that are spoken.
- articulate the role of celebration in preaching.
- utilize practical resources for strengthening genuine and celebratory preaching.

Thomas has served as senior pastor for congregations in Matteson, Illinois and Memphis, Tennessee.
