Course Description and Objectives

Course Description:

This course is a practical exploration of the gifts and challenges specific to Interim/Transitional Ministry. We will explore the necessary tasks for successful interim/ transitional ministry and the personality characteristics most helpful to develop for the practice of this specialized area of congregational leadership. We will examine the unique calling of persons to walk with congregations in both simple interim and long term intentional ministry situations.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this course students will be able to:

- 1. Identify the five (5) tasks of interim ministry.
- 2. Describe three (3) unique dimensions of transitional ministry as compared with "settled" congregational ministry.
- 3. Name three (3) personality characteristics that can affect the performance of interim ministry.
- 4. Name 3 situations particular to transitional/interim ministry which would provide opportunity to address issues of division and diversity.
- 5. Articulate a personal theology of transitional ministry.
